Jamp of the 230 Regt & Mich Orl Brys-Jumestown Tennasee Aug 27 the/868 Dear Wife an opportunity occurs to send back a letter so I will improve Of am well and in good spirits we have had a long march and over a hough road we are alt Jamestown in Jemasee on the top of the Cumberland Mountains and we are as pretty high the last hill we chimbed now five mules up are crossed the oumberland river at creeks foro by fording the water was only three feet deep and run verry swift some of the men fell down and got to little wet Vai it was before day light for we most alluray start og gory ochock so as to get throug our days march before it gets hot well we had a mountain to climb a mountain so steep that we had to let down rokes and poist up our cannon and wagons which tok 4 regement all day funday Then we marched ten miles to find a camping place where we found good water and plenty of are reached this place on the 25. Bust and have been waiting for our trains and

an other Division to come up more we have quite a force and will probably move on Vagain to morrow to meet the vallance of the 230 army Corps and the 9th army Corps and then commence operation on the brebs which are not far off at we now are where can expect them most any day we are going prepared for any There never was any Union troops in this part of the country before and the union portion of the people or what is left of them for there is not many left of any kind now lare about Seside them selves with for to see us come to their releas Ble country is almost desolate nothing growing mor any one to raise any thing. Ithe inhabitant all left the country forthe morth or in the reful army. only once in a while a man is left & thought of Law devolation in Hentuckey but it is nothing to Temasel, o as Shitter goes out to I baron in the morning and that is the only chance of sending la mail and that is at poor chance for it is in danger of getting gobbled be forlit getsout of Demasee however Fruill risk one letter and if they do golf they will not find any thing that will benefit them any Do here tit good any way we can not get any mad for some time for there is no mail rout established get

you must not worry about me now for of am ao safe here as any one and &t I you hear of a fight do solot get scart if you do not Then from me verry koon forth leder not send you any word his tell the mail goes out. and the one know when that will be Of have got to finish this pretty soon for the Mail Boy will be here for this in a little while. Heep up good Spirels and do not get die couraged in my absence and & will help To put down the brebellion as son as kerible you May soon look for un portant new from East Flundse and if we are exceptul it will help our cause amazingly. we have no bear of its being any other why for a more confident army never marched than this every one in the best of Spirits and ancious for Something to do. Last might I made an invention which is admired by every one that has seen it I look two com sacks land string them an two poles and drove four croteties in the ground and placed my poles and them and I had the best bed Dever Slepat on the bage sagged down between the poles and layed ad easy as could be, It was quick mad and cost shothing show there is Page my two before any one threw what they was good for
